23rd Special Session Called by Jim Gray

I attended the 1st day of the 23rd special session on Monday, December 14. This Special Session was called by Jim Gray whom of course was travelling and unable to present his "Executive Proclamation"

Tasha Ballard, attorney for Gray arrived to ask Assistant Chief, John Red Eagle to read Gray's Proclamation and rightfully the Assistant Chief denied the request. I asked Ms. Ballard where Gray was and she had no idea. She said: "I don't keep track of his travels." I replied, "How could you?"

I would suspect keeping track of a fly in a feed lot would be easier than keeping up with the Jet Setting Chief.

With regard to what came out of the Session, not much happened. Basically the same old thing with the exception that Red Corn, Edwards and Atterberry are

Independent Press Case

My suspicions are that Gray was home pouting or passed out from shock. The very idea that the Supreme court dismissed his Petition regarding the Independent Press debacle due to lack of jurisdiction most likely through him for a loop.

When he wakes up and reads the Court's opinion, he's going to find out he doesn't have what he likes to refer to as "Supreme Power" over the Osage Nation. Libby Lou better have an ambulance standing by. I don't think he'll be able to handle such reality.

Missing Memo

Apparently Shannon Shaw, Interim Editor of the Osage News didn't get the MEMO about the Supreme Court Decision on the Independent Press Case.

Early this morning I sent her an e-mail asking why my December News Article had not been posted on the Osage News Website. Once again, I was accused of making accusations with a simple question. Not only was I falsely accused but I was threatened to be completely cut off from further articles in the paper.

Well, apparently my reply didn't set well with her and as a result, I have been suspended from further articles in the Osage News.

This is a very sad and over the top situation we have with regard to what could be a fine news outlet for the Osage people. Because my article will not be in the news, I attach it under the heading: "Until Next Time."

I have attached the e-mail correspondence for your review. It is this type of treatment and unprofessionalism that certainly warrants an



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Independent Press for the Osage people.

Easy Does it!

Don't get carried away by this Court's decision. This suit was filed by Gray on July 14, 2008. That was 17 months ago. Considering there were no real defendants in the case because the suit was filed against "Interested Parties," it's difficult for me to understand why it wasn't thrown out and the matter resolved the day it was filed.

For one full year and 5 months, we have had to tolerate all these other dysfunctional actions of Jim Gray's which have resulted in millions of our dollars being squandered; when the Court could have and should have had this case and the Corbin (OFPR) case resolved in what I would refer to as "no brainer" work.

The Corbin Case

For months now, I have referred to the Office of

Finance and Performance Review as the Corbin Case. Gray filed a suit against the Senior Auditor of this office, the OFPR, Kelly Corbin, because Corbin was simply performing his duties. Because of this suit, Mr. Corbin has been unable to continue his obligation and responsibilities.

This is the suit that has prevented internal auditing of the Osage Nation Government.

Gray's Petition was filed on July 7, 2008. Seven (7) days prior to the Independent Press Case mentioned previously.

I attempted to get the status on this case in November to no avail. It seems to me considering that the Corbin case was filed prior to the Independent Press case, the Court should have a decision on it by the first of the year.

Considering that funds are being taken from Peter to

pay Paul or should I say the Burial Fund to pay the airline companies, and Gray seems to think he needs 52.2 million dollars to operate this year rather than the 21 million he used last year, it would be in the tribes best interest if the Court would perhaps take their responsibilities a little more seriously.

Given that major purchases to the tune of 4+million dollars for Air strips and quarter million dollar dirt piles are being purchased with our money, I have a difficult time believing audits are not in order.

Let there be no doubt. The big purchases of a quarter or more million are difficult to hide from the public. It's the 80 to 100 thousand dollar increments that are unknown to us all and I have no doubt of those, there are many. Could this be why the Education Fund fell short causing hundreds of students to go unfunded?



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Is it at all possible that this is why the Gaming Revenue has not been paid to the Osage Nation Government for months?

Was Mr. Corbin doing his job too thoroughly and honestly to suit Jim Gray?

So. Before we give too much credit to this Court system, let's wait and see what they come up with on this OFPR aka Corbin Case. We already know they denied the Congress access to the Tax Commission check book by approving the Treasurer's Motion to Quash the action and did so without a hearing on the matter.

Knowing What we Know

Considering just this first portion of these writings I must remind you that we STILL have four (4) Congress members backing Jim Gray. So again I have to ask. Need I say more?

Shall we Retain the Judicial?

On the 2010 Ballot we will have the option of retaining the judges in the Judicial Branch or not.

It is important to keep up with their performance.

So far, I'm not impressed and quite concerned. Elections have a funny way of bringing out the best in people though. Provided they do their work according to the Real law and not the Gray law from here on out, maybe they'll end up being keepers.

To Osage Government Employees

Let me first say that I truly empathize with you and sympathize your situation. I have a great deal of respect for all of you for having to work under these stressful, unpredictable circumstances but I would remind you that you are currently living in a vacuum of which is out of your control.

You have heard the idea of: "Looking from outside the box." Well, you're in the

box and I want to remind you of this. We are outside, looking in and we know what's going on. You on the other hand are inside and only know what Jim Gray wants you to know. You're in the vacuum and being controlled by untruths, fear and essentially brain washing.

Because we know this, for your sake and the sake of the Osage people as a whole, I am starting a series of reports that will help you understand and come to realize that those of us and the majority of the Congress are in your corner. We have your interest at heart and have concern for each and every one of you.
