Because of the ongoing attempts performed by the de facto Osage Nation government and Bureau of Indian Affairs, to usurp the Osage Tribal Council form of government and because of this DRAFT Settlement Agreement put forth on September 15, 2011, I have made the educated decision to not vote at all on the questionable ballot presented to me on or about August 26, 2011.

It is my understanding that Federal Judge Emily Hewitt in the U.S. Court of Federal Claims ruled in favor of the Osage Tribe regarding mismanagement of royalties owed me from Oil leases on the Osage Mineral Reservation from 1974 to 2000. The Judge also ruled that the tribe's estimates for the government's failure to properly credit interest income to the Osage Tribal Trust Account from 1973 to 1992 were reasonable and payable.

There were two other Tranches involved in this case. In an effort to move forward to a settlement figure, the other two Tranches were agreed upon and the total ordered settlement of this case was \$380 million. This settlement figure was so ordered by Judge Emily C. Hewitt and the United States Government was ordered to pay the Osage Tribe of Indians, aka Osage Indians who own a headright share in the Osage Mineral Estate their rightful share of the \$380 Million.

To my knowledge, the Judge did not give the United States Government, the de facto Osage Nation Government, the attorneys, Wilson Pipestem or the firm of Akin and Gump any orders to place whatever stipulations they wished to this settlement award as a wedge to take control of the Osage Tribal Council, my rightful government or my assets.

No further actions are required of anyone other than that the United States Government pays the \$380 million to the rightful Osage Shareholders.
