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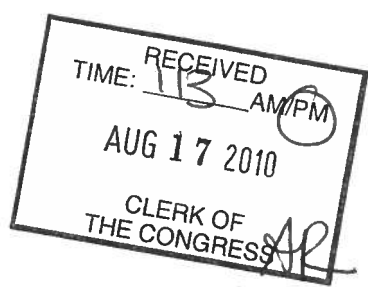

An Act

To provide an appropriation to the Osage Nation v. Thomas E. Kemp, Jr. et al. Litigation Fund in the amount of two hundred seventy seven thousand four hundred eight dollars (\$277,408); to establish an alternate effective date.

Be it enacted by the Congress of the Osage Nation:

SECTION 1. REPEAL OF ONCA 10-57

ONCA 10-57, an Act to provide an appropriation to the Osage Nation v. Thomas E. Kemp, Jr. et al. Litigation Fund, is hereby repealed by the Osage Nation Congress, and shall have no force or effect of law from the effective date of this Act or thereafter.

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATION

To carry out the purpose of litigating *Osage Nation v. Thomas E. Kemp, Jr, Chairman of the Oklahoma Tax Commission; Jerry Johnson, Vice-Chairman of the Oklahoma Tax Commission; and Constance Irby, Secretary-Member of the Oklahoma Tax Commission*, there is authorized to be appropriated to the Osage Nation v. Thomas E. Kemp, Jr. et al. Litigation Fund out of the general fund in the Treasury the sum of two hundred seventy seven thousand four hundred eight dollars (\$277,408) for the purpose of paying appropriate and reasonable attorney's fees and expenses.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION

The Osage Nation Congress hereby appropriates the sum of two hundred seventy seven thousand four hundred eight dollars (\$277,408) to the Osage Nation v. Thomas E. Kemp, Jr. et al. Litigation Fund to carry out the purpose of litigating *Osage Nation v. Thomas E. Kemp, Jr, Chairman of the Oklahoma Tax Commission; Jerry Johnson, Vice-Chairman of the Oklahoma Tax Commission; and Constance Irby, Secretary-Member of the Oklahoma Tax Commission*.

48 **SECTION 4. RESTRICTION AND REQUIREMENTS**

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50 The funds appropriated by this Act are subject to the restrictions and requirements
51 established in ONCA 10-26, which created the Osage Nation v. Thomas E. Kemp, Jr. et
52 al. Litigation Fund.

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54 **SECTION 5. DECLARATION OF AN ALTERNATE EFFECTIVE DATE**

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56 This bill is effective upon signature of the Principal Chief or upon signature of the
57 Speaker of the Osage Nation Congress following legislative override.
