Supernaw's recent Notes to the Nation has some good information regarding how you may want to handle your Osage Trust Case Settlement but he also informs that the de facto Osage Nation Congress will have to propose a resolution to accept the decision of the Minerals Council.

What this means is that this de facto government (of which I have stated time and time again has usurped the Osage Tribal Council and all of its previous control over the Mineral Affairs); will have the final say as to whether the Settlement is approved or not.

Supernaw indicates in his "Notes" that: ---Quote--- "the only involvement of the Congress will be to pass a resolution to accept the decision of the Mineral Council"— End Quote—
