| (BILL NUMBER ONCA 07-05) Sponsor of the Bill: William "Kugee" Supernaw TEXT: No Money shall be drawn from the Treasury of the Osage Nation, except by Appropriation in accordance with the Constitution of the Osage Nation Law. (Note: Simply abide by the law) The Chief Vetoed the Bill. A Vote to Override the Chief's Veto was held. Edwards voted against overriding the Chief's Veto. The Bill Passed. (See #6 ONCR 07-22 below) | NO |
| (BILL NUMBER ONCA 07-06) Sponsor of the Bill: William "Kugee" Supernaw TEXT: To provide for the establishment of the Osage Nation Internal Audit Department in order to provide an independent and objective consulting and review service for Osage nation operations; making an appropriation to establish the department; and declaring an emergency. (Simply establishing an Internal Audit Department –common in all successful businesses & corporations) | NO |
| (BILL NUMBER ONCA 07-60) Sponsor of the Bill: Faren Revard Anderson TEXT: "Osage Nation Savings Plan" (a) To create a Savings Plan for the Osage Nation. (b) To provide for a maximum longevity of the nation's current funding sources. (c) To inform the Osage people their elected government officials are planning ahead for future generations to come. (Simply establishing a Savings Plan in the Interest of the Nation) | NO |
| (BILL NUMBER ONCA 08-45) Sponsor of the Bill: Faren Revard Anderson TEXT: Fiscal Year 2009 Office of the Chiefs Appropriation Act: Note: An attempt to help the Chief manage our money more carefully. (Simply seeking accountability from the Chief) | NO |
| (BILL NUMBER ONCA 08-44) Sponsor: Doug Revard PURPOSE: The Constitution states in Section 5C (Annual Plan) of the Gaming Act that the Board shall submit an Annual Plan to the Congress no later than 60 days prior to the beginning of each fiscal year. The Annual Plan shall include: (g) Borrowing plans, including the plans to make, accept, endorse or issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes, mortgages or security agreements or any other instrument of indebtedness or guaranty exceeding \$500,000 (1/2 million dollars). ONCA 08-44 would amend this to: exceeding a cumulative annual amount of \$500,000 (1/2 million dollars) In other words, capping the ½ million to a cumulative amount in one year time rather than ½ million here, ½ million there throughout the year. | NO |
| ATTENDANCE: On last Report from the Osage Congressional Office, Congresswoman Edwards was absent 65 days out of the 215 days Congress was in Session. | ABSENT 65 DAYS |
