**Subject: Response to Congressman Red Corn**

Speaker Mason, Congress members: Anderson, Atterberry, Branstetter, Freeman, Red Corn, Red Eagle, Revard, Shackelford, Simms, Supernaw and Edwards:

On June 7, 2009 you received memorandums' from me regarding Article XII and proposal of a Constitutional Convention.

Along with this message, I provide a letter in response to Congressman Red Corn's answer to my memorandum. Though I did in fact receive a message regarding these issues from Congressman Red Eagle who indicated that I have valid points, I have seen no action to correct this situation.

To be fair to Congressman Red Corn, I believe it only right to inform you that my response to him clearly is to the Osage Nation Congress as a whole, therefore, I take this opportunity to direct you to its content and ask that you recognize yourselves as a recipient of this very message.

I would remind you that your employer is NOT Jim Gray, but the Osage people. I will assure you that I have many supporters. Supporters who have been intimidated and are fearful of retaliation should they speak out. I speak for them. This is why I'm here today and why I will be here for the duration.

A few of you have allowed this situation to become unconscionable. You have made poor decisions at the expense of the Osage tribe. You know who you are and the people know who you are. It's time to correct your wrongs and carry out your duties as elected representatives for the people.
