These heartfelt, compassionate promises carry no grey area or room for wavering. On this you can depend. I will consistently propose legislation to remove all minerals business from the New Osage Nation Constitution until I get it done.

Can't happen without you

Without you the informed voter, voting for like minded Congress members and a Chief truly concerned for the future of the Osage Tribe as we've known it, I may never succeed in getting such legislation passed. I cannot do this alone, nor can any individual. We must have 2/3 of the Congress voting in favor of doing this, therefore as always, I ask that you vote wisely. Because of the stacked deck put into place by the Gray Administration, many

are having difficulty selecting even 4 candidates out of the long list running for Congress. I find myself in the same situation.

I would add that the importance of the Chief rings true in this regard as well. If such legislation were to pass and the Chief we elect is not in favor of it, he can veto the legislation. Should this occur, we would then need 3/4 of the Congress voting to override the veto. Once again an amendment is called for to bring that percentage down to 2/3 as is provided for in most legitimate governments.

Reminder

Please remember and remind all friends and family members that the Application for an Absentee Ballot must be received by the Election Office by May 18. On advisement of the Election Board office, if you are mailing your applications via the U.S. Postal service, you should send them back by at least Wednesday,

May 5th. Keep in mind that these are only applications to receive an absentee ballot, there is no pressure to make voting decisions at this time.

Once again I am attaching the announcement on the matter for your review as well as an application for an absentee ballot.
