For 3 1/2 years, I have studied the actions of our leaders and representatives so that I would be an informed, viable candidate for the Osage government. These efforts have proven to be valuable and I hope an indication to you that I am sincerely dedicated to this cause.

I ask that you consider my willingness to make myself available to you these past 10 months as I will continue to do these next 3. Should I be elected to Congress, I will continue to be available at all times and my newsletters will

continue throughout my term. My website will remain as it is today and I will continue to inform the public as always.

Having the willingness to place myself before the Osage Citizenry as I have has proven to be a positive experience for me and I believe for the people. It is my belief that doing so is an act of respect to the citizenry by allowing you the opportunity to get to know me and understand my goals and intent. Yes, I have stumbled on occasion but had I not been working for the good of the citizenry, you never would have known it. This is a risk I've been willing to take in order to inform you of the many problems facing this government.

My efforts have been successful due to hard work, consistency and accuracy in reporting. In the last 10 months; I have accumulated over 2,000 recurring visitors to my website and am averaging 10 new visitors each day.

I am not running against any particular candidate, I am running for a Congressional seat in the Osage Nation Congress. There are 6 seats open in the Congress and I hope to fill one of them.
