

HOW TO LISTEN TO AUDIO ARCHIVES

Mineral Council Meetings

1. Go to: <http://www.osagetribe.com/> or (www.osagetribe.com)
2. On the right hand side of the page you'll see a column under the heading of "Quick Links."
3. Look for the **MEDIA** list.
4. Directly under the word **MEDIA** you'll see: [Audio/Video Archive](#)
5. Click on: [Audio/Video Archive](#)
6. When you get to the Audio/Video Archive page, notice the box that says "Search."
7. Type in the word "Minerals"
8. Click on "[Go](#)"
