An affidavit will be available for you to sign stating that you didn't vote the Absentee ballot.
- ✓ The Landrum Community Center is located on the North East corner of Hwy 60 and Hwy 99. The Osage Shareholders Association is offering a shuttle service to and from the Polling place on the hill. (Look for the new red brick building with the red

metal roof – that's it.)

- ✓ The Petition to Remove Shannon Edwards from Congress due to excessive absenteeism will be available for your signature at the Landrum Center along with Air Conditioning, coffee and donuts.
- ✓ Bring Grandma, Grandpa, Jr. and Uncle Pete with you we need their votes too! (I'm hearing rumors of Meat Pies and Strawberry Pop.)
