## Memory Lane

Because prudent voters realize they must look back at previous acts performed by elected officials in order to make educated decisions when marking their ballots, I've chosen to remind you of the **Executive Branch Protocol and Procedures for Working with, And Communicating to the Osage Nation Congress.** Copies of this document along with the **Clearance Request Form** for employees to complete before engaging in conversation with any Congress member, a copy of a letter from Speaker Mason to Jim Gray regarding this matter and the Transcript of a meeting of the Committee of the Whole during the FY 09 Hun-Kah Session is attached for your files and distribution to others. This particular act of Tyranny occurred the latter part of March 2009 and will play a major role in your process of elimination when viewing the list of candidates below. I ask that you keep in mind that this Protocol continues to be in effect as I write this newsletter.

## This Brings Up Questions

On the list of candidates provided at the end of this newsletter, there are 7 or 8 employees of the Osage Nation planning to run for office either in Congress or the Minerals Council and Assistant Chief. How is it that these candidates

are allowed to campaign and go about their business when the Executive Protocol explicitly requires them to complete a form for clearance prior to doing so?

How will it be possible for the voter to be honestly informed by these candidates when the Protocol states that they represent the Executive Branch, therefore are required to conduct themselves accordingly?

Is it possible that these candidates have been encouraged to run for office by the Executive Branch itself? Sure it's possible. This is to be expected and part of the political process. There is nothing wrong with it. Actions such as these are not illegal or ethically questionable. These are choices for you the voter to make.

If elected, will these employees be allowed to serve their elected positions and continue to work for the Osage Nation simultaneously? I couldn't say. The Constitution denies such activities but it's all in whom you are that such a determination will be made.

If the employees of the Osage Nation running for Minerals Council are elected to the Council, will these employees be able to function without

speaking freely to the Osage Nation Congress?

Recall that the Minerals Council begged for a second approval from the Osage Nation Congress to allow them to have their own election. How has it been possible for Jewell Purcell, Kathryn Red Corn and Talee Red Corn, employees of the Nation and Minerals Council Members, to communicate so freely with the Congress? Have they been serving at the pleasure of the Executive Branch? This is possible considering that the Protocol states that they represent the Executive Branch; therefore are required to conduct themselves accordingly. Never mind the possibility of losing their jobs, retirement, health benefits and other perks including longevity of employment should they cross the grain of the Chief.

## Tyranny

*Black's Law Dictionary:* *Arbitrary* or *despotic* government: the severe and *autocratic* exercise of sovereign power, either vested constitutionally in one ruler, or *usurped* by him by breaking down the division and distribution of governmental powers.

- Arbitrary
- In an unreasonable manner, as fixed or done capriciously or at



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pleasure. Without adequate determining principle; not founded in the nature of things; non rational; not done or acting according to reason or judgment; depending on the will alone; absolutely in power; capriciously; tyrannical; despotic; not governed by any fixed rules or standard. Willful and unreasoning action, without consideration and regard for facts and circumstances presented.

- **Despotic**
- *Despotism:* That abuse of government where the sovereign power is not divided, but united and unlimited in the hands of a single man, whatever may be his official title. It is not, properly, a form of government.
- **Autocratic**
- *Autocracy:* The name of an unlimited monarchical government. A government at the will of one man (called an "autocrat"), unchecked by constitutional restrictions or limitations.
- **Usurped**

- *Usurpation:* The unlawful encroachment or assumption of the use of property, power or authority which belongs to another. An interruption or authority which belongs to another. An interruption of the disturbing a man in his right and possession. The unlawful seizure or assumption of sovereign power.
- The assumption of government or supreme power by force or illegally, in derogation of the constitution and the rights of the lawful ruler.

It appears that this administration continues toward the goal of complete dictatorship not only of the Minerals Estate but the Osage Nation. Succeeding to get his "people" elected into these offices will take him one step closer to reaching that goal.

If you are not aware of the 6/6 split in Congress, it would serve you well to go over the voting records provided on my website by clicking the VOTING RECORDS link. Here you will find where Raymond Red Corn, Debbie Atterberry, Mark Freeman and Shannon Edwards played a major role time and

time again to keep democracy from prevailing by voting against legislation. These four Congress members have consistently backed the Chief and still do today. Two of the six apparently came to the realization that such decisions were not wise. They were Eddy Red Eagle and Archie Mason.

Raymond Red Corn is running for a second term. Shannon Edwards is a 6 year congress member and will not be up for re-election for two years. Mark Freeman and Debbie Atterberry are not seeking a 2<sup>nd</sup> term.

Be this as it may, I bring these things to your attention to help you make informed decisions on June 7<sup>th</sup>. If you are "OK" with this information, you will vote accordingly and if you are not "OK" with it, you will vote accordingly. This is your right as a voter at this point in time. I have worked too hard these past 3 ½ years and have too much money invested in this endeavor of informing the citizenry of the true facts. I am pleased with the outcome of my work and believe I have earned a seat in Congress. Not only have I earned it, I without a doubt will work to protect our heritage and future for our children, grandchildren, great grandchildren and beyond as well as ourselves.
