Ms. Miller,

I am reserving an opinion on a Constitutional Convention until after the fall session. If the Congress is successful in passing some resolutions (which I intend to pre-file soon), two things will happen:

1. It will show that Congress is indeed capable of originating efforts for Constitutional change by mustering 10 votes to put amendments before the people and
2. Those amendments, if passed by the Osage electorate in the 2010 election, will provide reasonable signature thresholds for those wishing to circulate petitions for initiative, referendum, recall, and constitutional amendment in the future.
