Subject: Constitutional Convention

Speaker Mason, Congress members: Anderson, Atterberry, Branstetter, Freeman, Red Corn, Red Eagle, Revard, Shackelford, Simms, Supernaw and Edwards:

After having visited with the Legislative Counselor, Loyed “Trey” Gill, III, I request that you propose legislation in the Tzi-Zho Session that will make available to the Osage Public, an opportunity to vote for a Constitutional Convention in the 2010 election.

To provide this opportunity to the Osage people is only right and individual Congressional positions on the matter should not be a determining factor. Inaction on your part denying the Osage public this opportunity will be an indication that not only Jim Gray but Congress is in favor of a tyrannical government.

This Constitution is the source of our failure. You, as a congressional body, have proven to the people that amendments are not an option.

I would ask that you seek counsel from Mr. Gill on this issue. I believe the Tzi-Zho Session will allow ample time to get this option on the ballot.
