You can do a website search by entering (example: Arizona Newspapers) Once you do this, some states will have a list of all newspapers. As you click on each newspaper, you will be provided with a CONTACT US link. Click on the link and

send your letter to the Editor of the newspaper and WALLAH! You've done it!
