FROM RUMORS TO SILENCE

There's a lot of speculation going on at the constituent end while all's quiet on the Congressional end. This is what happens when elected officials fail keep the public informed.

CONGRESS HUNG UP

Budgets, appropriations and projected revenues are the hot topic as of late and should be no surprise to any of us. If you recall, the September Newsletter (1) indicated Gray's proposed budget for the Executive Branch to be 52.5 million dollars. Gray's loyal Congresswomen, Debbie Atterberry and Shannon Edwards proudly sponsored the bill (ONCA 09-53)

For the past few days, Congress has been in Special Session attempting to whittle down proposed appropriations for these outrageous budget requests but with projected revenue of 27 million, and a budget for the Executive Branch alone at 52.2 million, I have to

wonder what the outcome will be.

ROB THE RESERVES?

At no surprise to me, a few of the usual Congress members of whom we know we can count on to support irrational thinking and less than prudent solutions, are pushing to get into the reserves in order to meet the unrealistic budget requests. According to Raymond Red Corn's Update #99, there is 55 million in the reserve account.

Red Corn further indicates that our 12 Congress members seem to be confused and unable to comprehend what the definition of Projected Revenue is. The best I can tell, the two Congress members having the most difficulty with the definition are: Shannon Edwards and Raymond Red Corn. I'll miss my guess if Debbie Atterberry and Mark Freeman aren't having a hard time figuring it out as well.

This question has gotten so out of control that the Congress is still trying to figure it out and it has gotten so amazingly ignorant that they are actually trying to decide if Projected Revenue" means net or gross revenue!

Red Corn's statement: *"A Contrasting opinion holds that "projected revenues" includes the funds in the Treasury. These funds have not been obligated by appropriation, and have not been reserved for any particular purpose by law. I subscribe to this definition. There are other definitions that may apply."* (Raymond Red Corn)

Clearly Red Corn wants to dip into our reserves to pay for the unnecessary, outrageous expenditures of which we obviously cannot afford and will not be able to carry out on the projected income from the Casinos and Tax Revenue which is 27 million and of course, that figure is nothing more than a guess.

RESULTS ARE IN!

Folks. It's this type of thinking that has gotten us in the shape we're in today and it goes on and on and on!

Jim Gray, Raymond Red Corn, Debbie Atterberry and Mark Freeman have approximately 7 more months to remain in office. They are doing all they can to get into what little reserves we have left.

Some of you may look at 55 million as being a great deal of money but had these four congress members pulled the corset strings in on Jim Gray in 2007 and 2008, we would have had much more money in the reserves and we wouldn't have the operating expenses we have today.

The fact of the matter is. This projected income of 27 million would have been satisfactory today had there been 12 realistic Congress members representing us. It is clear on the voting records that these four Congress members have caused legislation to fail by voting against it. Legislation that would have corrected and saved us from the circumstances we face today.

REMOVAL PROCESS

While Congress hashes over the definition of "Projected Revenue" what is being done about implementing a Removal and Recall process to get some of this detriment removed?

Shannon Edwards, a six year Congress member will remain in office for another two years unless some sort of viable, concrete bill is passed making removal possible.

Miss Edwards is certainly in my view a prime candidate for removal. 65 days of absence has long since been reported and she continues to blow off her responsibilities through absenteeism.

Of course, during special session, she jets off to France with the rest of the "side show", leaving her duties in Congress wanting only to come back and attempt a hatchet job on the work accomplished in her absence!

Arrogance and crude behavior along with pooh poohing the people in my view adds icing on the cake of dereliction of duty.

ANOTHER NOTE ON THE SUBJECT

As mentioned previously, the projected income includes not only the Gaming Revenue but the Revenue from the Tax Commission.
